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The RJE3 Program (East Russia Japan Expert Education Program) was adopted by the Inter-University Exchange Project (part of the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology) in 2014. This program is designed to develop specialists who are expected to be active in the Far East and the Arctic, in collaboration with Hokkaido University and the five partner schools of Far Eastern Federal University (Vladivostok) in the Far East of Russia, North-Eastern Federal University (Yakutsk), Pacific National University (Khabarovsk), Irkutsk State University (Irkutsk), Sakhalin State University (Yuzhno-Sakhalinsk)

Prep subjects is programs for undergraduates who want to go to graduate school and through training and practical training in various cities and universities in Russia, classes will be offered as "Russian beginner's class" to learn about the historical culture, language and social situation. This year, eight fourth graders from the Faculty of Engineering participated in the "International Forum New Idea of New Century" held at the Pacific National University in Khabarovsk, Russia.

The forum, which was held for about a week, presented graduation thesis and workshop announcements and an exhibition of graduation design, and our university student won the Grand Prix in the graduation thesis presentation. International forums such as English dissertation and workshops with Russian students were a valuable experience for the participating students.

In addition, students at Pacific National University, who are the host of the program, have been able to deepen their interaction through excursions, etc. in the city, as well as providing support in various situations when participating in a forum or during a stay. It is expected that it will be a great harvest for students in Japan, and will take the first step as an advanced professional to solve the problems in the Far East and the Arctic Circle in the future.

From the second part, people from local governments and companies in Hokkaido will also participate, and after giving a presentation on their own research and career after the program's participation by the alumni, "About future university-company cooperation" Based on the theme, we held the " Sustainable Development Study Meeting ", which is regularly implemented by the RJE3 program.

In this Study Meeting, after introducing the field work provided by the RJE3 program and explaining the main achievements of the students participating in the program, the local government and companies suggested to the university side about the possibility of collaboration with the company, and we were able to have a lively discussion from various perspectives. We hope that this content will be used in the future activities of the RJE3 Consortium, and will lead to the activation of the RJE3 program in the future.
